Revocations

A. To revoke:

Vale) (Prohibition of Driving) Amendment Order 1984.

Prohibition of Driving

B(1) To prohibit, with certain exceptions, driving on these lengths of road as set out in Schedule 1 to this notice.

Deliveries of goods or merchandise to or from premises will be allowed between the hours of 5 p.m. on any day and 11 a.m. the next day following. Exemptions will be provided in the Order in pursuance of statutory duties, emergency services and a funeral.

To prohibit, with certain exceptions, driving between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on that length of road set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.

The Order will come in to operation on 18th November 1988.

The Order and a map showing the affected roads may be inspected at the County Hall, Cwmbran, during normal office hours (Monday to Friday). If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 10th November 1988, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Haringey (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) (Width Restriction) Traffic Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 10th November 1988 made the Haringey (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) (Width Restriction) Traffic Order 1988 under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the Haringey (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) (Width Restriction) Traffic Order 1988.
