NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority N.R.A. Unit by David Charles Pull, Hall Farm, Ringstead Hunstanton, Norfolk PE36 5JZ for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from Babingley River, adjoining Mill Marsh, Day Common and Night Marsh, in the parish of Castle Rising, at the following points of abstraction:—

31,818 cubic metres between 1st May and 30th September in any year at any points between National Grid References TF669255 and TF688254 in the Parish of Castle Rising in the District of King's Lynn in the County of Norfolk.

The water is required for spray irrigation.

CONTROL OF POLLUTION ACT 1974 NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 34(1)

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

WEYMOUTH & PORTLAND BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Weymouth and Portland
(Various Roads)
(24 hour Urban Clearway) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Weymouth and Portland acting on behalf of the Dorset County Council in pursuance of arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, and in exercise of the Dorset County Council's powers under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultations with the Chief Officer of Police have made an Order the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time in the lengths or road specified in the First Schedule to this Order.

The Order will operate from the 14th November 1988. A copy of the Order together with the relevant map can be seen at the Municipal Offices, North Quay, Weymouth during normal working hours.

If anyone wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made 10th November 1988, apply to the High Court for the purpose.

<i>New Road, Portland</i>	From a point 212 metres south west of its junction with Old Hill in a south westerly direction to the beginning of Priory Road.
<i>Priory Road, Portland</i>	
<i>Yeates Road, Portland</i>	
<i>Easton Lane, Portland</i>	From Yeates Road to the termination of the 30 mph speed limit north of its junction with Grove Road.
<i>Wide Street, Portland</i>	From Easton Lane to the termination of the 30 mph speed limit north of its junction with Reforme.

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Portland Street Area, Mansfield) Traffic Regulation Order 1988 (248)

Notice is hereby given, that the Nottinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which (respecting roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield) will be:

- (1) There will be a prohibition of waiting at any time for vehicles on part of Quarry Lane;
- (2) The No Right Turn prohibitions (a) from Bishop Street into Portland Street and (b) from Quarry Lane into Portland Street, will be revoked;
- (3) There will be a No "U" Turn (a) from Portland Street/St. Peters Way northbound carriageway to the southbound carriageway and (b) from Portland Street (at a point 45 metres south of St. Peters Way) southbound carriageway to the northbound carriageway;
- (4) There will be a No Right Turn for vehicles from Lord Street into Portland Street;
- (5) There will be a prohibition of loading or unloading of vehicles on Mondays to Saturdays between 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. in parts of Nottingham Road and Portland Street;
- (6) There will be consequential amendment of existing traffic regulation Orders.

The usual exemptions will be provided. Relevant documents may be inspected at my Office or at the Library, Four Seasons Centre, Westgate, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire. Written objections (stating grounds) must be received by me by 7th December 1988.
