ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

NORTH HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

*(Bancroft, Hitchin) (Prohibition of Waiting
and Prohibition of Right Hand Turn) (No. 2) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the North Hertfordshire District Council acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council made an Order on 15th November, 1988 under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is:—

- (1) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in the length of Bancroft, Hitchin, described in the under-mentioned Schedule; and
- (ii) To prohibit any vehicle proceeding in Bancroft, Hitchin from making a right-hand turn into the Bancroft car park for the duration of the operation of the temporary traffic signals.

It is intended that the proposals contained in this Order shall operate for approximately one year, in connection with works to be carried out to provide additional car parking on the former Russell's site in Bancroft, Hitchin. On completion of those works, appropriate steps will be taken to restore the waiting restrictions which apply at present to the length of Bancroft referred to.

(Note: The Order originally made by the Council on 12th July 1988, contained an error prohibiting the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, instead of Mondays to Saturdays).

A copy of the Order and a plan may be inspected at my office and at the District Office, Brand Street, Hitchin, between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
