Notice of Application for Licence to Obstruct or Impede the Flow of an Inland Water by Means of Impounding Works

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Yorkshire Water Authority by Keighley Angling Club, 4 Compeigne Avenue, Riddlesden, Keighley, West Yorkshire, for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of Cottingley Beck by means of a 4 Foot High Manonry Dam at NGR SE 1090 3511. Stony Lane, Allerton, Bradford District. (The object of impounding water by means of works is to create an Angling Pond) The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 135,000 gallons (614m³).

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Blackpool (Various Roads) (Various Restrictions) and (Revocation) Order 1989

Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984 propose to make the above Order.

The Order will have the following effect:

(1) *Waiting will be prohibited at any time on the following lengths of road:*

Arnold Avenue (from property No. 94 to opposite property No. 33 Arnold Avenue—South side.

Back Adelaide Street/Albert Road (off Regent Road)—Both sides.

Back Cambray Road/Warbreck Hill Road (off Hodgson Road)—Both sides.

Back street linking Seabourne Avenue to The Crescent—Both sides.

Blackpool Road (from a point 9 metres south of Red Bank Road for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction)—Both sides.

Bolton Street (Crystal Road to Alexandra Road)—West side.

Cherry Tree Road North (for a distance of 30 metres south of vehicular entrance to Gazette premises)—Both sides.

Dover Road (for a distance of 15 metres east of vehicular entrance to Moorland Motors opposite Wood Park Road)—North side.

Mansfield Road (from vehicular access to Symbol Biscuits factory (Gate No. 2) for a distance of 105 metres in a northerly direction)—West side.

Morston Avenue (for a distance of 9 metres north of Warbreck Hill Road)—Both sides.

Mowbray Drive (Depot Road to Westfield Avenue)—North side.

Peter Street (from a point 9 metres west of Devonshire Road to Selbourne Road)—North side.

Platt Street (fronting properties Nos. 2-12 inclusive)—East side.

Promenade (for a distance of 15 metres north of Cocker Square—East side.

Richmond Road (Egerton Road to side street adjacent to property No. 2 Richmond Road)—East side.

Salmesbury Avenue (for a distance of 9 metres east of Bispham Road)—Both sides.

Side street off Dickson Road (Adjacent to Nos. 147-151)—Both sides.

Side street off Bolton Street (Adjacent to No. 61) (including rear of 429-435 Promenade)—Both sides.

Woodland Grove (for a distance of 15 metres east of Whitegate Drive)—North side.

(2) *Waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the following length of road:*

Mexford Avenue (Raymond Avenue to Warley Road)—West side.

(3) *Waiting will be limited to 60 minutes in any two hour period between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive on the following lengths of road:*

Adelaide Street (for a distance of 32 metres west of Leopold Grove)—North side.

Leopold Grove (from a point 5 metres south of Adelaide Street to a point 5 metres north of Albert Road)—East side.

Livingstone Road (fronting properties Nos. 35-43 incl.)—West side.

(4) *Proposed One-way Street*

No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in a northerly direction in the side street off Church Street (adjacent to No. 213) linking Leamington Road.

(5) *Vehicles will be prohibited from driving in the following roads, other than for the purposes of gaining access to premises in those roads:*

The Crescent.
Seabourne Avenue.
Jesmond Avenue.

Arlington Avenue.
Severn Road.
Trent Road.
