 - (b) vehicles whose drivers hold a permit issued by the Highway Authority provided they proceed in a southerly direction only.
- 2. You will not be allowed to drive your vehicle into Fleet Street at its junction with The Strand and Cary Park, except for buses on local services and emergency vehicles.
 - 3. Drivers will not be allowed to make the following turns:

Right-hand turn from The Terrace into Fleet Street; Left-hand turn from Braddons Hill Road West into Fleet Street; Left-hand turn from George Street into Fleet Street.
