## WATER RESOURCES ACT AND DROUGHT ACT 1976

### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Thames Water Authority by ARC Southern, Stoneleigh House, Frome, Somerset, BA11 2HB for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from Wet Gravel Pit, Horcott Pit, Fairford, Glos. at the following point of abstraction 200,000,000 gallons per annum at SU 150998, Horcott, Fairford.

Further details of the application are Abstraction and Recirculation of water for gravel washing purposes.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Council of the County of North Yorkshire (Restriction of Waiting) (Cove Road, Malham) (Experimental) Order 1989*

Notice is hereby given that on 17th January 1989, the Council of the County of North Yorkshire made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. each day for a period of twelve months in any length of road specified in the following table:

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Lengths
Cove Road	East	From a point 70 metres north of its junction with Chapel Gate for a distance of 390 metres in a northerly direction.
	West	From a point 100 metres north of its junction with Chapel Gate for a distance of 360 metres in a northerly direction.

A copy of the Order which comes into operation on 31st January 1989, together with a map showing the road affected, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton, and at the Craven District Council Area Office, Town Hall, Settle, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks of 30th January 1989, make application to the High Court for the purpose.

### DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dyfed (Portfield, Haverfordwest)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1989*

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of this Order will be:

- (1) to prohibit waiting at any time on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (2) to revoke the County of Dyfed (Portfield, Haverfordwest) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1975 in so far as it relates to the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the side of road affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the side of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council, at County Hall, Carmarthen, and at the Highways Department, at the County Offices, at St. Thomass' Green, Haverfordwest, during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 27th February 1989.

### SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

#### *New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan*

Notice is hereby given that, on 31st January 1989, the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, made Orders the general effect of which is to impose traffic restrictions on the lengths of road referred to in Column 1 of the Schedule below.
