TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Cornwall) (No. SW 2) Order 1988" authorising the stopping-up of a length of highway (formerly A389) from its junction with Sarahas Lane, Padstow, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of that Act.
