between HER MAJESTY'S ATTORNEY GENERAL (Plaintiff)
and MARCUS DAVID JONES (Defendant).

Upon reading the Originating Summons (deemed an Originating
Notice of Motion under order 94 Rule 15) herein dated the 21st April
1988 issued by the Plaintiff Her Majesty's Attorney General seeking
a civil proceedings Order against the above named Defendant
pursuant to Section 42 of the Supreme Court Act 1981 as amended
by Section 24 of the Prosecution of Offences Act 1985 that:

- (i) no Civil proceedings shall without the leave of the High Court
be instituted by the above named Defendant in any Court and
- (ii) that any Civil proceedings instituted the said Defendant in any
Court before the making of the Order shall not be continued by
him without the leave of the High Court and
- (iii) that no application (other than an application for leave under
this Section) shall without leave of the High Court be made by
the said Marcus David Jones in any Civil proceedings instituted
in any Court whether by him or another on the ground that the
said Marcus David Jones has habitually and persistently and
without any reasonable ground instituted vexatious Civil
proceedings in the High Court and made vexatious applications
in the High Court County Court and Court of Appeal in Civil
proceedings instituted by him or by others

1. instituting any Civil proceedings in any Court and
2. continuing any Civil proceedings instituted by him in any
Court before the making of this Order and
3. making any application other than an application for leave as
required by this Order in any Civil proceedings instituted
whether by him or another in any Court unless he obtain the
leave of the High Court and satisfies the Court that the
proceedings or application are not an abuse of the process of the
Court in question and that there are reasonable grounds for the
proceedings or application
