TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (London Borough of Camden) (No. 3) Order 1989" authorising the stopping up of a part of Fulwood Place, London W.C.1.

The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Norfolk) (No. 3) Order 1989
