HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County of Cornwall (Egloshayle By-pass Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1989

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the Council:

- (a) to carry out the improvement of highways;
- (b) to stop-up highways;
- (c) to construct new highways;
- (d) to stop-up private means of access to premises; and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises;

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the Egloshayle By-pass in the District of North Cornwall which the council are proposing to construct.

Copies of the Order, the relevant plan and the statement of reasons may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 13th July to the 1st September, 1989 at the County Hall, Truro, the offices of the North Cornwall District Council, Priory House, Bodmin and Trevanion Road, Wadebridge, and at the Town Hall, Wadebridge.

Any person may, not later than 1st September 1989, object in writing to the confirmation of the Order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport at his address at the office of the Director (Transport), south West Region, Exeter Office, Falcon Road, Exeter EX2 7LB, stating the grounds of objection.
