ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

SPELTHORNE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Road Traffic Regulation Order 1989

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Spelthorne on 21st July, 1989, made the above Order under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order comes into operation on 1st August, 1989.

(a) The effect of the Order is as follows:

No person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden cause or permit any motor vehicle at any time to proceed in the Market Square, as shown edged orange on Plan 0380/P/10 ("the Plan") except those mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

Access to the Market Square will be via the new access road to be constructed to the west of No. 2 Clarence Street, Staines, as shown on the Plan and the existing accesses will be closed.

No person shall permit any motor vehicle to wait in the access road at any time.

No person shall cause any motor vehicle to wait in the laybys to be constructed in the positions shown edged green on the Plan, except for the purpose of a person entering or leaving that motor vehicle or for the purposes of loading and unloading.

No persons shall cause any motor vehicle to turn right out of the access road into Clarence Street, Staines.

(b) The following properties:

1—3 Market Square, Staines; 5 Market Square, Staines; 5A Market Square, Staines; 7 Market Square, Staines; 7A Market Square, Staines; 9 Market Square, Staines will be serviced via the two laybys aforesaid.

(c) The Order revokes those parts of The Urban District of Staines (Various Roads, Staines) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1973, and The Spelthorne Borough Council (Various Roads, Staines) (Prohibition and Revocation of Waiting) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1978, that relate to Market Square.

(d) A copy of the Order and Plan may be inspected at the address below between 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

(e) If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 21st July, 1989, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
