Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 7th August 1989 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Council of the Borough of Luton ("the Council") as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to extinguish the public right of way described in the Schedule below.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be submitted with the Order.
