TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

Notice is hereby given that a local public inquiry is to be held into a proposal by the Secretary of State for Transport to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act. If made this Order would authorise the diversion of Valley Road, Newhaven in the county of East Sussex to enable development consisting of 132 dwelling houses and associated car parking to be carried out in accordance with

planning permission granted by Lewes District Council under Part III of the Act.
