Application for Drought Order—River Wharfe

Notice is given that Yorkshire Water Services Limited is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for six months) under Section 131 of the Water Act 1989:

(a) varying a restriction to which the Company is subject as respects abstraction of water from the River Wharfe at Ilkley at NGR SE 099483 under Licence Number 2/27/19/5 which limits the rate of abstraction to 2,000 million gallons per annum at the maximum rate of 7.5 million gallons per day. The Order would reduce the rate of abstraction to 1,460 million gallons per annum at a maximum rate of 4 million gallons per day;

(b) varying a restriction to which the Company is subject as respects abstraction of water from the River Wharfe at Lobwood at NGR SE 075520 under Licence Numbers 2/27/19/128 and 2/27/19/129 which limits the aggregate amount of water to be abstracted under those Licences to 6,023 million gallons per annum at a maximum rate of 20.5 million gallons per day. The Order would permit abstraction up to a maximum of 11,242 million gallons per annum at a maximum rate of 30.8 million gallons per day.

The Order would also limit, to the amount specified in column 2 below the aggregate amounts of water that may be abstracted under Licence Numbers 2/27/19/128, 2/27/19/129 and 2/27/19/5 on any day when the flow in the River Wharfe is less than 50 million gallons per day and the amount of water in Grimwith Reservoir is within the limits specified in column 1 below.

Application for Drought Order Hebden Valley and Withens Clough Reservoirs

Notice is given that Yorkshire Water Services Limited is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for six months) under Section 131 of the Water Act 1989 authorising temporary alterations to the normal statutory prescribed flow or compensation water discharge from the Company's under-mentioned reservoirs whereby the prescribed flow or statutory discharge from the reservoirs set out in column 1 of the Schedule into the watercourses set out in column 2 are modified so that whenever the aggregate amount of water contained in the Company's reservoirs in the Calder, Bradford and Skipton areas does not exceed 48,429,000 cubic metres the prescribed flow or discharge specified in column 3 shall be altered to the quantities set out in column 4, and whenever the said aggregate amount of water exceeds 48,429,000 cubic metres but does not exceed 64,571,000 cubic metres the said prescribed flow or discharge shall be altered to the quantities set out in column 5.
