THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Cardiff, Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) The Newtown, Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A44) (Trunk Roads and Junction Improvements, Llangurig) Order 1989.

The Cardiff, Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) The Newtown, Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A44) (Trunk Roads and Junction Improvements, Llangurig Side Roads) Order 1989.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

(1) an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 which will:

(a) provide that highways which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation:

(i) a route about 280 metres in length starting at a point about 98 metres north-east of the property known as "Felin Fawr" then going in a general north-easterly direction to a point about 365 metres north-east of the property known as "Felin Fawr"; and

(ii) a route about 117 metres in length starting at a point about 595 metres north-east of the property known as "Felin Fawr" then going in a general north-easterly direction to a point about 710 metres north-east of the property known as "Felin Fawr".

(b) provide that a length of the Cardiff—Glan Conwy Trunk Road A470 to be superseded by the new trunk roads mentioned

above shall cease to be a trunk road and shall become an unclassified road, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Powys (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the said new trunk roads are open for through traffic; and

(2) an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter the existing A470 Trunk Road;

(b) to stop-up highways;

(c) to construct a new highway which will be a footpath;

(d) to stop-up private means of access to premises, and

(e) to provide new means of access to premises

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the new trunk roads mentioned above and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Powys as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for use.

Any person aggrieved by either Order, and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from 6th October 1989 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or any provision contained therein.
