The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders and Scheme:

1. An Order under sections 10, 12, 41 and 106 of the Highways Act 1980 providing:

(a) that a new road 2.70 kilometres in length which he proposes to construct from a point on the Trunk Rend approximately 186 metres north of the junction of the Truick Road and the unclassified Montgomery Road proceeding in an easterly and then southerly direction to a new roundabout, including the said roundabout, the centre of which is on the western bank of the River Usk approximately 95 metres north of the centre line of the M4 Motorway at the eastern end of the existing Brynglas Tunnels; together with 2 new link roads (westbound -1.01 kilometres in length, eastbound -1.03 kilometres in length) which connect the new Brynglas roundabout to Junction 25 of the Motorway (Caerleon Interchange), shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Orther corner into force and this Order comes into force, and

(b) authority for him to construct as part of the new link roads from the Brynglas roundabout to Junction 25 of the Motorway (Caerleon Interchange), 2 bridges over the River Usk.

- 2. An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that by the construction of the road under 1(a) above, the length of the Newport-Shrewsbury Trunk Road (A4042) to be superseded, shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given to Gwent County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for the new road) that the new road is open for through traffic.
- 3. A Scheme under sections 16, 17 and 19 of the Highways Act 1980 varying "The East of Christchurch-Tredegar Park Motorway Connecting Roads Special Roads Scheme 1965" which provided the existing connecting roads on the western side of Junction 25 (Caerleon Interchange) of the Motorway, and substituting for these connecting roads two new connecting roads further to the west which will link the Motorway to the new trunk roads running between the Brynglas roundabout and Junction 25 of the Motorway.
- 4. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:

(a) to carry out the improvement of highways;

(b) to stop up highways;

- (c) to stop up highways temporarily;
  (d) to construct new highways and construct new highways for temporary purposes;
  - (e) to stop up private means of access to premises, and (f) to provide new means of access to premises;

all between a point 25 metres north of the railway bridge crossing the A4042 near Newport Castle to a point on the existing A4042 Trunk Road approximately 186 metres north of the junction of that road with the unclassified Montgomery Road, and including all the new trunk roads between the new roundabout on the west bank of the River Usk at the eastern end of the Brynglas Tunnels and Junction 25 of the Motorway.

5. An Order under section 18 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him to stop up the existing connecting roads on the western side of Junction 25 (Caerleon Interchange) of the Motorway.
