ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
—SECTION 14*Banned Turns at Western Avenue (A40) and Long Lane
Junction*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he intends to make an Order to prohibit all turning movements at the junction of Western Avenue (A40) and Long Lane in the London Borough of Hillingdon while resurfacing works are carried out.

The restriction, when indicated by traffic signs, will apply between 8 p.m. on 22nd January 1990 and 6 a.m. on the following day and between the same hours on subsequent days until the works have been completed which, with favourable weather conditions, is expected to be within a period of 6 weeks.

Traffic may enter or leave Western Avenue at its junction with Swakeleys Road and Park Road.

*The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Hertfordshire) (No. ?)
Order 198?*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of Archtech Partnership, he proposes to make an Order under Section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of highway verge adjacent to number 74 Harmer Green Lane, Digswell, Welwyn, Hertfordshire to enable development consisting of the erection of a front boundary wall to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Mr David Payne by Welwyn Hatfield District Council under Part III of the said Act.
