ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

Birmingham City Council (Victoria Square, Birmingham)
(Prohibition of Use of Highways by Public Service Vehicles) and
(City Centre Pedestrianisation) (Variation) and (Parking Places
and Controlled Parking Zone) (Birmingham) (Variation)
(No.) Orders 199.

Notice is hereby given that the above-named council propose to make three Orders under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(2), 19 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be as follows:

- To prohibit public service vehicles entering and proceeding in that length of road known as Victoria Square and which extends from its junction with Colmore Row to its junction with New Street.
- (2) To extend the present pedestrianisation of Chamberlain Square to include Victoria Square but including an exemption for pedal cycles and vehicles engaged on civic duties.
- (3) To introduce no waiting at any time in Chamberlain Square and Victoria Square.
- (4) To introduce two way traffic operation in that length of Victoria Square which extends from its junction with New Street to its junction with Chamberlain Square to enable entry and egress of authorised vehicles to the pedestrian area.
- (5) To vary the existing Traffic Regulation Orders insofar as they conflict with these proposals.

Full details of the proposals ae in the draft Order which, together with a map and a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposals, may be examined at the offices of the Central Executive Department Directorate of Law and Regulation, Paradise Place, Birmingham B3 3EH, during normal working hours.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should write to the undersigned stating the grounds for objection by 12th February 1990.
