#### SCHEDULE 1

##### *In the Parish of Alrewas in the District of Lichfield*

Pasture land north of Fradley Lane, arable land east of A38 Trunk Road access track and stream south-east of Fradley South Service Area. (All owned by H. C. Woolley & Sons) (1/1, 1/3, 1/4 and 1/7).

Arable land south of Fradley Lane and east of A38 Trunk Road, the right to lay and maintain pipe and construct and maintain a culvert headwall in arable land south of Fradley Lane. (All owned by Arblaster Brothers) (1/2, 1/11 and 4/1).

Arable land on east of Jefsfire Kennels. (Owned by M. J. Webb) (1/5).
