Sides of Lengths of Road in the Borough of Taff Ely

Sides of lengths of roads authorised to be used as street parking places during the permitted hours.

Position in which vehicles may wait.

Classes of Vehicle.

- 1. The western side of Lanpark Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of its junction with the spur of Lanpark Road southwards to the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 13 Lanpark Road a distance of a approximately 116 metres (127 yards).
- The north-western side of Lanpark Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from a point 15 metres (16 yards) northeast of its junction with Tyfica Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 63 metres (69 yards).
- The eastern and south-east side of Lanpark Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from a point 15 metres (16 yards) south of its junction with the spur of Lanpark Road southwards and south-westwards for a distance of 200 metres (220 yards).
- 4. The north-western side of Tyfica Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from the common boundary of Nos. 33 and 35 Tyfica Road, north-eastwards to the northeastern boundary of No. 63 Tyfica Road a distance of approximately 140 metres (154 yards).
- 5. The south-eastern side of Tyfica Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from a point 15 metres (16 yards), northeast of its junction with Lanpark Road northwestwards to a point opposite the south-western boundary of No. 7 Lanpark Road, a distance of approximately 132 metres (145 yards).
- The north-western side of Tyfica Road, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from the common boundary of Nos. 5 and 7 Tyfica Road north-eastwards for a distance of 88 metres (97 yards).
- The north-western side of Graigwen Place, Graigwen, Pontypridd, from the northern side of its junction with Graigwen Road to a point 9 metres (10 yards) southwest of its junction with Thomas Street, a distance of approximately 96 metres (105 yards).

Wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway by broken white lines conforming to diagram 1032 in Schedule 2 to the 1981 Regulations and parallel to the kerb with the nearside of the vehicle adjacent to the edge of the carriageway.

Passenger vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, goods vehicle, invalid carriageway and motor cycle.

HEREFORD & WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Various Roads, Worcester) Various Traffic Orders 1990

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make Orders under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (4), 3(1) and (2), 32(1) and 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers the effects of which will be:

(1) (Union Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Vehicles of over 8 metres in length) Order 1990

To prohibit any vehicle exceeding 8 metres in length from proceeding along the entire length of Union Street in the City of Worcester in the county of Hereford and Worcester.

Exemptions are contained in the Order for the following purpose if the vehicle is being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

(2) (Pump Street, Worcester) (Parking Places for Disabled Persons Vehicles) Order 1990

To restrict the parking of vehicles on that side of length of Pump Street in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice to those carrying disabled persons and displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's "orange badge" scheme for gaining access to St. Andrew's Methodist Church.

Any person parking in the side of length of road specified above shall not necessarily prevent access to any premises adjoining the side of length of road or the use of the side of length of road by other persons or so as to be a nuisance.

The County Council reserves the right to suspend parking in these streets to enable any street procession to take place or prevent obstruction or for any other appropriate reason.
