2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978, so that:

- (a) in the length of street specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice between the times specified in Column 2 waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle subject to paragraph 2(b) below) would be prohibited;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods, or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., on Mondays to Saturday inclusive, subject to being without prejudice to any other provisions contained in the Harrow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978;

The prohibitions referred to in paragraphs 2(a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles lawfully displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply. 4.
