The Oldham (Various Roads, Uppermill) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Oldham Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be to amend the Greater Manchester County (Various Roads, Uppermill) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1975, so as to remove existing No Waiting restrictions between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and 8 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. on Saturdays on the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this notice. No Waiting at any time restrictions will be introduced on the lengths of roads set out in Schedule 2 to this notice.

There would also be no loading/unloading between 7.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Monday to Saturday and between 4 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday on the length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

The Greater Manchester County (Various Roads, Uppermill) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) Order 1980, will also be amended so as to remove the No Waiting restrictions between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and 8 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. on Saturdays on Smithy Lane from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with High Street to a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Lee Street.

The Greater Manchester County (Various Roads, Uppermill) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) Order 1980 (Amendment) (Borough) Order 1985 will be revoked.

Appropriate exemptions will be included in the Order.

New Street:

Extending from its junction with High Street to its junction with Church Road on the north side

Extending from its junction with High Street for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction on the south side.

Extending from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Village Green to a point 5 metres east of that junction on the south side.

Church Road, extending from its junction with New Street to its junction with Pick Hill Lane on the north side.

Village Green:

Extending from its junction with New Street to its junction with Smithy Lane on the east side.

Extending from its junction with New Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction on the west side.

Extending from its junction with Smithy Lane for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction on the west side.

Station, Road, extending from a point 25 metres south-east of its junction with Smithy Lane to its junction with the access road to Saddleworth Pool on the south and west sides.

Smithy Lane, extending from a point 15 metres east of its junction with High Street to a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Lee Street on both sides.

Passage at Western Gable of Dam Head Mill, extending from its junction with Smithy Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction on both sides.

Un-named access road to Saddleworth Swimming Pool, extending from its junction with Station Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 120 metres on both sides.
