The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) on behalf of a statutory undertaker or British Telecommunications and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984, under, in, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway.

During 28 days from 21st May 1990 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the Weymouth and Portland Municipal Offices, North Quay, Weymouth DT4 8TA, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Department of Transport at the address stated below (quoting ref. DSW505235/1/106).
