## SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan*

Notice is hereby given that on 17th May 1990 the County of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made Orders the general effect of which is to impose traffic restrictions as published on 19th March 1990 in the *London Gazette* ref. 481 the lengths of road referred to of the Schedule below. The nature of the restriction is shown in column 2.

The Orders will come into operation on 22nd May 1990 or on the date that the necessary lines and signs are placed on site, whichever is the later, and their titles are shown in column 3 of the Schedule.

Copies of the Orders and plans showing the affected areas are available at the address shown below, where they may be examined between the hours of 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

If you wish to question the Orders provisions or validity on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the ground that any requirement of, or any instrument made under the Act, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 17th May 1990 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
