Drought Orders

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment has made the following Orders:

The Southern Water Services Limited (River Medway) (Drought) Order 1990, which came into force on 17th May 1990, and which authorises the Company to abstract water for public supply from the River Medway at Springfield, near Maidstone, Kent, below the licensed minimum residual flow.

The Southern Water Services Limited (Plucks Gutter) (Drought) Order 1990, which came into force on 12th May 1990, and which authorises the Company to abstract water for public supply from the River Stour at Plucks Gutter, Monkton, Kent, below the licensed minimum residual flow.

The Southern Water Services Limited (Medway Groundwater) (Drought) Order 1990, which came into force on 12th May 1990, and which authorises the Company to abstract water for public supply from boreholes in north Kent.

The Southern Water Services Limited (Thanet Groundwater) (Drought) Order 1990, which came into force on 12th May 1990, and which authorises the Company to abstract water for public supply from boreholes in east Kent.

Taking and discharging of water in the Isle of Wight

Notice is hereby given that, because of an exceptional shortage of rain, a serious deficiency of supplies of water is threatened within the Isle of Wight being part of the water supply area of Southern Water Services Limited. The Company therefore is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 131(4)(a) and (c) of the Water Act 1989, to enable the Company for a period of 6 months from the making of the Order.

(i) To abstract up to the amounts of water per day shown in column (2) of Table A below from each of the existing boreholes described in column (1) thereof:

Water Shortage

Notice of application for an emergency order relating to abstraction from the lower Tamar Lake

Whereas in view of an exceptional shortage of rain, a serious deficiency of supplies of water is threatened in the area of South West Water Services Limited, the statutory water undertaker, which is served from the Upper Tamar Lake in the Parish of Bradworthy and Pancrasweek in the District of Torridge and Kilkhampton in the District of North Cornwall in the county of Cornwall.

Notice is hereby given that in order to maintain an adequate supply of water the Company is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order pursuant to section 131(4) and 133(5) of the Water Act 1989, to enable it for a period not exceeding six months to provide a temporary intake and pumping installation at Lower Tamar Lake (NGR SS294108) and to abstract therefrom a quantity of water not exceeding 3 megalitres per day subject to a compensation release from the Lower Tamar Lake equivalent to that released from the Upper Tamar Lake.

A copy of the statement and a plan illustrating the Company's proposals may be inspected by any person, free of charge, during all reasonable office hours at the office of the undersigned and at The Civic Centre, Plymouth (Sixth Floor) and Bude-Stratton Town Council, The Castle, Bude, Cornwall, for a period of seven days from the date of the publication of this Notice.

Objections to the application may be made to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Room B449, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1 3PY, (with a copy to the undersigned please quoting ref. 442/58/KGS) within seven days of the publication of this Notice.

Where it appears to the Secretary of State that the Order is required to be made urgently if it is to enable the Company effectively to meet the deficiency of supplies of water referred to above, he may direct that the holding of a Public Local Inquiry or a hearing by a person appointed by him shall be dispensed with.

The Bolton (High View Street, Sharples) (Prohibition of Driving) (No.) Order 1990
