TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Tyne and Wear) (No. 10) Order 1990" authorising the stopping-up of the whole of the unnumbered footpath lying between Grainger Street, Newgate Street and Clayton Street (Newgate Shopping Centre), and an adjoining triangular shaped area of the southern footway of Newgate Street, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, to enable the refurbishment of pedestrian areas, construction of new shop units and roofs to enclose malls, and the installation of security shutters, to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Lilley & Mitchell Partnership per Gordon E. Andrews Associates by Newcastle-upon-Tyne City Council under part III of the said Act.
