DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Saltash Road, Keyham, Plymouth) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Amendment Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

1. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles for more than 2 hours in any period of 4 hours between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., Monday to Saturday, on part of the east side of Saltash Road;
2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on part of the east side of Saltash Road;
3. To revoke the County of Devon (Saltash Road, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1978;
4. To revoke part of the Second Schedule of the City of Plymouth (Devonport Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1969 insofar as it relates to part of the east side of Saltash Road.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks, the maintenance of essential services and for vehicles used by disabled persons in accordance with the "orange badge scheme".

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the address given below.

DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Crescent Road, Llandeilo) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of this Order will be:

- (1) To prohibit waiting at any time on the side of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- (2) To prohibit waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the sides of road affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the "orange badge scheme".

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the sides of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, and at the offices of Dinefwr Borough Council, Crescent Road, Llandeilo, during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 6th August 1990.

SCHEDULE 1

Waiting Prohibited at Any Time

Crescent Road, on the west side, from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with the Trunk Road A483 at Central Square to a point 50 metres north-west of the entrance to the car park, a distance of approximately 50 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting Prohibited between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Crescent Road, on the east side, from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with the Trunk Road A483 at Central Square to its junction with Latimer Road, a distance of 70 metres.

ELLESMERE PORT AND NESTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (Wellington Road and Marina Drive) Order 1989

Notice is hereby given that the Ellesmere Port and Neston Borough Council (on behalf of the Cheshire County Council pursuant to and agreement under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972) made the above Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (the Act) and of all other powers the Council enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act on 5th July 1990. The Order will become operative on 16th July 1990.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (1) Revoke the Borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (Various Roads, Town Centre) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1985.
- (2) Vary the Borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (Rivington Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976 by deleting therefrom each and every reference to Hackney Carriages.
- (3) The Order provides that licenced Hackney Carriages whilst plying for hire may wait in the section of Marina Drive which is defined as a Hackney Carriage Stand by carriageway markings prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981.
- (4) Provide for licenced Hackney Carriages whilst plying for hire to wait in the section of Wellington Road, which is defined as a Hackney Carriage Strand by carriageway markings prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981.

A copy of the Order and relevant map and all other relevant documentation under Regulation 16(1)(f) of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1989 (No. 1120), may be inspected free of charge at the Borough Solicitor and Estates Officer's Department, Whitby Hall Lodge, Whitby Park, Stanney Lane, Ellesmere Port, South Wirral, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the ground that any requirements of the Act or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within 6 weeks from 12th July 1990, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
