NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with Schedule 12 paragraph 5 of the Water Act 1989, that a Consent has been served by the National Rivers Authority (Anglian Region) upon Anglian Water Services Ltd., in order to control an unconsented discharge of trade effluent into Covenham Reservoir, near Louth, Lincolnshire, at National Grid Reference TF 348 965. The discharge, which is now subject to the consent and the conditions thereof, comprises reservoir inlet water dosed with ferric sulphate solution and is being discharged for the purpose of reducing the phosphorus concentration in the reservoir water (and thereby limiting the development of blue-green algal populations).
