The Approval of Safety Standards Regulations 1987 (SI 1987-1911); Regulations 2 and 3

NOTICE NO. 6

The safety provisions of the standards mentioned below have been approved by the Secretary of State as standards of safety for the purposes of section 10(3) of the Consumer Protection Act 1987. This is a cumulative list of all standards so far approved; those with an effective date of August 1990 are sidelined.
