Lengths of Road and Side of Lengths of Road in the Borough of Ogwr

MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The Mid Glamorgan County Council (Heol Llangeinor (Route A4064) and Heol Tynon, Llangeinor) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1990.

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- (i) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the length of road and side of length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- (ii) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles, except for buses, at any time on the side of length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order to enable Medical Practitioners and Veterinary Surgeons to visit while "on call" and for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading, unloading, building and road works, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, inspection or survey of the length of road, and sides of lengths of road, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a map showing the length of road and sides of lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Ogwr Borough Council, Civic Offices, Angel Street, Bridgend, and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff during normal office hours.

GWENT COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gwent County Council (Regent Street/Victoria Street Area, Abergavenny) (Traffic Regulation) Orders 1990

Notice is hereby given that Gwent County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be:

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of waiting at any time

Regent Street

- (a) Western side for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction from the southern kerb-line of Brecon Road (A40).
- (b) Eastern side for a distance of 83 metres in a southerly direction from the southern kerb-line of Brecon Road (A40).

Victoria Street

- (a) Northern side from a point 28 metres west of the north-western kerb-line of Baker Street for a distance of 28 metres in a westerly direction.
- (b) Southern side from a point 24 metres west of the north-western kerb-line of Baker Street for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.

Victoria Street Rear Access Road

- (a) Western side for a distance of 29 metres in a northerly direction from the northern kerb-line of Victoria Street.
- (b) Eastern side for a distance of 26 metres in a northerly direction from the northern kerb-line of Victoria Street.
