

### RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

#### NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 19th September 1990:

- (i) Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- (ii) The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in section (3) of the said section 5 shall be:

*The Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (Mold By-pass, Side Roads) (No. 2) Order 1990*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to temporarily stop up a highway at Mold in the County of Clwyd.

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (Mold By-pass) Order 1990*

*The Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (Mold By-pass, Side Roads) Order 1990*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

- (1) An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 which will:

(a) provide that a road about 5.82 kilometres in length commencing at a point on the trunk road about 340 metres south-west of its junction with Upper Bryn Coch Lane, extending in an east then north-easterly direction to a point on the trunk road about 380 metres east of its junction with Bryn Lane at Mold in the county of Clwyd shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into force;

(b) provide that the length of the Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road to be superseded, shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Clwyd (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new trunk road is open for through traffic;

(c) provide that the Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (Mold By-pass) Order 1977 (SI 1977/1436) be revoked.

- (2) An Order under sections 12, 14, 125 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980, authorising him:

(i) to carry out the improvement of highways;

(ii) to stop up highways;

(iii) to construct new permanent highways;

(iv) to construct a temporary highway;

(v) to stop up private means of access to premises;

(vi) to provide new means of access to premises, and

(vii) to provide for the revocation of the Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (Mold By-pass, Side Roads) Order 1977;

All at Mold aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Clwyd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
