#### Tender for Sterling Treasury Bills

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday, 28th September 1990 at I p.m. for sterling Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of  $\pounds 200,000,000$  for Bills due 63 days after date, £250,000,000 for Bills due 91 days after date and £200,000,000 for Bills due 182 days after date.

The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, 1st October 1990 to Friday, 5th October 1990 inclusive.

The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

Each tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates and different tenors.

Notification will be sent on the day of the Tender to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part.

If delivery of Treasury Bills into the Central Moneymarkets Office has been requested, payments will be effected through that system; otherwise payment in full of the amount due in respect of an accepted Tender must be made to the Bank of England, not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relevant Bills are to be dated and on which they are to be collected from the Securities Office, by one of the following means:

(a) cash;

(b) banker's draft payable through the Town Clearing;

(c) cheque drawn on the Bank of England;

(d) CHAPS payment (subject to evidence of payment).

(Bills will only be released by the Bank of England when evidence of payment has been received.)

Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Securities Office, Bank of England. Particular froms are available for Bills of each maturity.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right to reject any Tenders. (8 SI)

#### PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-Line Works Authorisation The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that he has decided to issue, and in consequence has issued, a works authorisation to Mobil North Sea Limited, whose address is Mobil Court, 3 Clements Inn, London WC2A 2EB for the construction of an 8.5 inch pipe-line between the Ness II P4 line subsea valve and the Ness II P4 production well 9/13b-49.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the pipe-line shall only be used to convey crude oil and its associated hydrocarbons, formation water and chemical mud.

The pipelines may be used by the holder and with the holder's agreement and, with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons.

Mobil North Sea Limited has been appointed operator of the pipe-line.
