(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 59) ORDER 1990**
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Great Grimsby Borough Council, acting as agent for the Highway Authority, the County Council of Humberside, propose to make a Road Traffic

Regulation Order under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be as follows: (i) to impose restrictions for waiting limited to 1 hour, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, with return prohibited for 2 hours in Riby Street, on the north side, from a point 60 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Tomline Street, to the eastern kerb-line of Tomline Street, and in Riby Square, on the east side, from a point 11 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Riby Street, to a point 9 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Orwell Street; (ii) to revoke some existing restrictions for no waiting at any time in Riby Street and Riby Square, which will be replaced by the restrictions set out in (i) above, and to revoke some existing restrictions for waiting limited to 1 hour, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, with return prohibited for 2 hours, in Kesgrave Street, on the east side, from a point 14 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Orwell Street, to a point 14 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Cleethorpes Road. The Order will come into effect on 8th October 1990. If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of the Order, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
