The Stopping-up of Highways (Victoria, Ebbw Vale, Gwent) Order 1990

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that following a public local inquiry held on 17th July 1990, he has made the above Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to enable the development of a car park and access porch on land adjoining a funeral home, for which planning permission has been granted, to be carried out.

In accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, the length of highway to be stopped-up has been reduced from 22 yards (20.12 metres) to 16.8 metres.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of Blaenau Gwent Borough Council, Municipal Offices, Civic Centre, Ebbw Vale.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act

he may within 6 weeks of 11th October 1990, apply to the High Court for suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximate)

The highway to be stopped-up is at Ebbw Vale in the county of Gwent and is that length of un-named road, which extends from a point 2 metres from its junction with Victoria Road in a north-easterly direction, for a distance of 16.8 metres. (1 SI)
