

(d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and

(e) to provide new means of access to premises,

all at or in the vicinity of the above mentioned new trunk road and providing for the transfer of each new highway to the County Council of North Yorkshire from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for through traffic.

The A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (East London River Crossing, A13 to A2) No. 6 Supplementary Compulsory Purchase Order (No.) 19

Notice is hereby given, that the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the above-mentioned Acts has prepared a draft Compulsory Purchase Order, entitled as above, which he proposes to make authorising him to purchase compulsorily the land described in the Schedule to this Order for the following purposes:

- (i) the construction of a slip road to connect with the main new trunk road at Beckton in the London Borough of Newham in pursuance of the A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (East London River Crossing (A13 to A2) Slip Roads) Order 19 (as proposed to be modified on making);
- (ii) the provision of new means of access to premises in the said London Borough in pursuance of the A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (East London River Crossing (A13 to A2) Side Roads) Order 19 (as proposed to be modified on making); and

(iii) use by the Secretary of State in connection with such construction and the execution of other works mentioned above.
