ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Rushden) (Traffic Regulation)
(Amendment) Order 1990*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on 15th October 1990, he made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A6 Trunk Road, at Rushden in Northamptonshire.

2. The effect of this Order which comes into force on 17th October 1990, will be to prohibit waiting at all times on a length of the east side of the A6 Trunk Road (Rectory Road) from its junction with George Street southwards for a distance of 38 metres.

3. Notice of the Secretary of State's intention to make this Order was published under the reference number T7982/28/0680, on 12th June 1987, in the *London Gazette* under the title *The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Rushden) (Traffic Regulation) (Variation) Order 1987*. The effect of this Order is the same as described in that notice but modified to exclude the proposed waiting prohibition on a length of the A6 Trunk Road known as High Street and to amend *The Rushden Urban District (Street Parking Places) Order 1969*, by deleting the provision of a 2 hour maximum waiting period on the section of George Street mentioned in paragraph 2 above.

4. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made

under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 16th October 1990, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
