

constructed by him pursuant to the Order referred to at paragraph 3 below shall become trunk roads as from the date the Order comes into force.

(2) The A249 Trunk Road (M2 to Bobbing Improvement De-trunking) Order 199 . This is an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 which if made, will provide that a length of the A249 Trunk Road to be superseded by the new trunk roads referred to in paragraph 1 above shall cease to be a trunk road, and shall be classified as a classified road, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies Kent County Council that those new trunk road are open for through traffic.

(3) The A249 Trunk Road (M2 to Bobbing Improvement Side Roads) Order 199 . This is an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 which if made, will authorise him to:

- (a) improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
- (b) stop up highways;
- (c) construct new highways;
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises.

all at or between Stockbury Valley and Bobbing and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the Kent County Council as from the date on which he notifies the Council that they have been completed and are open to through traffic.

Any person may, not later than 11th January 1991 or within 12 weeks from the date of publication of this notice if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Orders, by notice to the Secretary of State at his address at the South East Construction Programme Division, Federated House, London Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1SZ, quoting Ref. No. PSE/A249/4/65/2/3 and stating the grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
