

AREA 3

Hutton Avenue:

On the north side of the road from a point 52 metres west of its junction with St. Paul's Road and thence in a westerly direction for a further distance of 255 metres.

On the south side of the road from its junction with St. Paul's Road and thence in a westerly direction for a total distance of 307 metres.

Clifton Avenue, on both sides of the road from its combined junction with St. Paul's Road and Osborne Road and thence in a westerly direction up to its junction with Eltringham Road, a total distance of approximately 225 metres.

Stanhope Avenue, on both sides of the road from its junction with Osborne Road and thence in a westerly direction up to its junction with Eltringham Road, a total distance of approximately 216 metres. (501)

AREA 1

Windsor Street, on both sides of the street from its junction with Lister Street and thence in a northerly direction for approximately 140 metres.

Lister Street:
