The Inhabitants of Barce-Iona were in great Distress for want of Provisions and it was thought they would surrender the Place foon after the arrival of Mareschal Berwick, who had been constituted General in Chief of all his Ca tholick Majesty's Forces, and was expected at the

Camp on the 6th Instant.
