Declaration of National Nature Reserve, Parishes of Wheldrake, Thorganby, Sutton-upon-Derwent and Cottingham, Counties of North Yorkshire and Humberside.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949, and section 35 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, that by the Lower Derwent Valley National Nature Reserve No. 2 Declaration 1991, made on 24th January 1991, the Nature Conservancy Council declared that the land containing 159·815 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parishes of Wheldrake, Thorganby, Sutton-upon-Derwent and Cottingham, in the counties of North Yorkshire and Humberside, and shown edged black on the plans attached to the said Declaration the subject of an Agreement entered into with the Nature Conservancy Council and is being managed as a nature reserve.
