

Newport Borough Council, Civic Centre, Godfrey Road, Newport, Gwent NP4 4UR, on Tuesday, 12th March 1991 at 10 a.m. when representations from persons who have objected to the draft Order, and from any other persons who wish to appear, will be heard.

The proposed Order, which has been applied for by Newport Harbour Commissioners under section 14 of the above Act, provides for the repeal of some sections of the Newport (Monmouthshire) Harbour Act 1836 relating to the rates or duties or charges payable to the Commissioners by the users of their harbour, including provisions which confer exemptions from rates or duties or charges

on vessels returning to the harbour during the same voyage or making over thirty voyages within a specified twelve month period.
