TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

North Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council—Seaton Valley (Footpath No. 56) Public Path Temporary Diversion (No. 1) Order 1990.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 247, 253 and 261 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf has made an Order entitled The North Tyneside Metropolitan Borough Council—Seaton Valley (Footpath No. 56) Public Path Temporary Diversion (No. 1) Order 1990, the effect of which will be to divert for a period not exceeding 2 years and 6 months, a length of Seaton Valley Footpath No. 56, in the Metropolitan Borough of North Tyneside, starting from a point 7.5 metres south-west of the southern highway boundary of the A1(T) (Spine Road West) near Backworth, and running south-westwards for a distance of 162.5 metres on to a new line to the east of the aforementioned length of footpath starting

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
