### DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a part of the eastern footway of Queensberry Way, London S.W.7, to enable development consisting of a new refuse area to be located to the rear of the Norfolk Hotel at Nos. 2 to 10 Harrington Road, involving part demolition of existing rear boundary wall and insertion of new opening in wall to facilitate means of escape, to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Dry Butlin Bicknell Limited.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a rectangular shaped area of highway verge adjoining the southern boundary wall of No. 101 Stannington Grove, Ashbrooke, Sunderland, to enable development consisting of change of use from forecourt to private garden to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Mr. A. Schofield, by Sunderland Borough Council under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Tyne and Wear) (No. 5) Order 1991", authorising the stopping-up of the whole of the unnamed highway lying between Windermere Street West and Back Windermere Street West, and a short adjoining length of Back Windermere Street West, Gateshead, to enable development consisting of extensions to Gateshead Talmudical College to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Bernard Joseph (architect), on behalf of Gateshead Talmudical College, by Gateshead Metropolitan Borough Council, under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971. The Order requires the improvement of Back Windermere Street West by the provision of a turning head.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied within relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 25th April 1991, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
