TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has revised his proposal published in draft on 15th November 1990 and now proposes to make an Order entitled "The A19 Trunk Road (Slip Road) (50 m.p.h. speed limit) Order 1991", under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the slip road which leads from the northbound carriageway of the A19 trunk road to the eastbound carriageway of the A66 trunk road, a distance of approximately 730 metres.

A copy of the draft Order, a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a plan illustrating the proposals, may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Director Network Management and Construction, Department of Transport, Northern Region, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne NE1 4TD, the offices of the County Secretary, Cleveland County Council, PO Box 100a, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough TS1 2QH.

The closing date for the receipt of objection is 28th May 1991.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of Durham A691 Witton Gilbert By-Pass Classified Road (Side Roads) Order 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the above Order which was made by the Durham County Council under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council—
