ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956 LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980

The Maltby/Thurcroft/Dinnington Smoke Control Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (as amended) on 6th February 1991 proposed to make the "Maltby/Thurcroft/Dinnington Smoke Control Order 1991". It is proposed that the area shown in the Schedule attached hereto be a Smoke Control Area, and that the said Order be operative on 29th February 1992.

Subject to the exemptions to be provided by the said proposed Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the proposed Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.
