NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SEVERN-TRENT REGION

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn Trent Region of the National Rivers Authority by Dwr Cymru Cyfyngedig of Pentwyn Road, Nelson, Treharris, Mid-Glamorgan to vary licence serial number 18/54/9/367 which authorises the abstraction of water from a well at Leintwardine in the Leominster District of the county of Hereford and Worcester at National Grid Reference SO 404 737.

The variation being applied for is to increase the daily rate of abstraction from the site from 140,000 gallons (636 cubic metres) per day to 220,000 gallons (1,000 cubic metres) per day, and to increase the annual quantity from 40,880,000 gallons (185,818 cubic metres) to 80,300,000 gallons (636 cubic metres) per day to 220,000 gallons (365,000 cubic metres) in any calendar year. In addition the variation seeks to increase the number of wells authorised for operation within the proximity of the existing pumping station to three.
