HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The A41 London-Birmingham Trunk Road, (Berkhamsted By-pass Side Roads) Order 1990 Variation Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the new trunk road to be constructed by him as a by-pass to Berkhamsted in the county of Hertfordshire, to make, under sections 12, 14 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980, an Order varying the A41 London-Birmingham Trunk Road (Berkhamsted By-pass Side Roads) Order 1990, which authorises him to carry out various highway works, in particular improvements of existing highways and construction of a new Highway at Bourne End.

The effect of the variation is:

- (a) to extend improvements of Chesham Road A416 westwards, and
- (b) to alter the position of the new highway at Bourne End (which is to replace a length of London Road A41) and minor incidental works of improvement of that road.

Copies of the draft Order, together with the made side roads Order, and of the relevant plans, may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours from 21st May 1991 until 5th July 1991, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the Department of Transport, Room S3/04, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, and at the offices of the Department of Transport, Eastern Construction Programme Division, Heron House, 49-53 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL; at the offices of Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford and Dacorum Borough Council, Civic Centre, Marlowes, Hemel Hempstead; and at the Berkhamsted Public Library and the post offices in Northchurch and Berkhamsted.

Any person may, not later than 5th July 1991, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, object to the making of the Order, by notice to the Secretary of State at his office at the Department of Transport, Eastern Construction Programme Division, quoting ref. 235/3/26/06 and stating the grounds of objection.
