Basildon District Council - Speed Limit Order

The District of Basildon (Oak Road, Billericay) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1991

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Basildon, pursuant to arrangements made with the Essex County Council under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, and in exercise of the powers of the County Council under sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV, Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act intends to make the following Order, the effect of which will be to prevent any person from driving any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. in Oak Road, Billericay, in the District of Basildon, for a distance of approximately 1,514 metres from its junction with Hardings Elms Road to its junction with Gardiners Lane North.
