### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

## Designation of Conservation Area

Notice is hereby given that Craven District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") has designated the area referred to in the Schedule A to this notice as a Conservation Area under section 69 and 70 of the Town and Country Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990. The effect of the designation is that.

- (i) no building in the Conservation Area may be demolished without obtaining listed building consent from the Council,
- (ii) anyone wishing to cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage or wilfully destroy any tree in the Conservation Area shall give the Council 6 weeks notice of this intention,
- (iii) the Council will give special attention to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the Conservation Area.

A plan of the designated area may be inspected during office hours at the Council Offices, Granville Street, Skipton, North Yorkshire.

#### Hellified to Langcliffe Railway Conservation Area To Form Part of the Settle to Carlisle Railway Conservation Area

From the main signal box at Hellified, the area includes Station Villa, Station House, Hellified Station, the site of the former Engine Shed and Long Preston Station. Approaching Settle Station from the south, the area includes Settle Junction, Midland Terrace on Station Road, Settle Station, the Station House and the Tank House.

This includes all the land between and including the lineside walls and fences alongside the track from Hellified to the Yorkshire Dales National Park boundary at Longcliffe. (730)

PLANNING (LISTED BUILDING AND CONSERVATION AREAS) ACT 1990

#### **Conservation Area: Braunston Village**

Notice is hereby given that the Daventry District Council in exercise of its powers under section 69 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 has designated the village of Braunston as a Conservation Area.

By virtue of the Act, no building in a Conservation Area may be demolished either completely or in part unless the prior consent of the local planning authority has been obtained. There are penalties for demolishing building without first obtaining consent.

Before work is carried out affecting any tree in a Conservation Area, 6 weeks notice in writing must be given to the local planning authority, stating the work proposed, together with sufficient particulars to identify the tree(s) concerned. It is an offence under the Act to cut down, top, lop, uproot or wilfully damage or destroy any such tree without consent.

There are certain exceptions to each of the above requirements, and any person contemplating such action should contact the Daventry District Council for advice.

A plan showing the extent of the Conservation Area may be inspected at the Planning Department, District Council Offices, Lodge Road, Daventry, during normal office hours.
