NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application is being made to the Welsh Region of the National Rivers Authority by Dwr Cymru Cyfyngedig of Pentwyn Road, Nelson, Treharris, Mid Glamorgan to vary licence serial number 19/55/1/15 B which authorises the abstraction of a total of 90,000 gallons (409 cubic metres) of water per day and up to 32,940,000 gallons (149,727 cubic metres) per annum from the Conyn Springs at National Grid Reference SN 965 703 and from the Nant Saun Stream at National Grid Reference SN 939 712 near Rhayader in the District of Radnor in the County of Powys for water undertaking purposes. The variation applied for is to vary the point of abstraction such that the authorised quantities of water can be abstracted at either the existing abstraction points or from the River Wye at Builth Wells in the District of Radnor in the County of Powys at National Grid Reference SO 0329 5220. The variation applied for is to vary the point of abstraction such that the authorised quantities of water can be abstracted at either the existing abstraction point or from the River Wye at Builth Wells in the District of Radnor in the County of Powys at National Grid Reference SO 0329 5220. In addition notice is hereby given that an application is being made

to the Welsh Region of the National Rivers Authority by Dwr Cymru Cyfyngedig of Pentwyn Road, Nelson, Treharris, Mid Glamorgan to vary licence serial number 19/55/2/78 which authorises the abstraction of 200,000 gallons (909 cubic metres) of water per day up to a maximum of 73,200,000 gallons (16,104,000 cubic metres) per annum from the River Irfon at Llanwrtyd Wells in the Borough of Brecknock in the County of Powys at National Grid Reference SN 867 473 for water undertaking purposes. The variation applied for is to vary the point of abstraction such that the authorised quantities of water can be abstracted at either the existing abstraction point or from the River Wye at Builth Wells in the District of Radnor in the County of Powys at National Grid Reference SO 0329 5220. In addition notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Welsh Region of the National Rivers Authority by Dwr Cymru Cyfyngedig of Pentwyn Road, Nelson, Treharris, Mid Glamorgan to vary licence serial number 19/55/3/38 which authorises the abstraction of 2,000 cubic metres (440,000 gallons) of water per day up to a maximum of 732,000 cubic metres (161,040,000 gallons) per annum from the River Wye in the community of Llanelwedd, Builth Wells in the Radnor District in the County of Powys at National Grid Reference SO 0329 5220 for the purposes of water supply by a statutory undertaker. The variation applied for is to increase the daily rate of abstraction from 2,000 cubic metres (440,000 gallons) per day to 3,682 cubic metres 810,000 gallons) per day and to increase the annual rate of abstraction from 732,000 cubic metres (161,040,000 gallons) per annum to 1,347,612 cubic metres (296,474,640 gallons) per annum. In addition the condition relating to the authorised means of abstraction (which is currently a surface mounted pump of 100 cubic metres per hour capacity) is to be varied to be a surface mounted pump of 200 cubic metres per hour capacity. The effect of these four variations is to combine the existing authorised quantities from the four licences which will allow Dwr Cymru—Welsh Water the operational flexibility to make better use of its existing resources without increasing the total licenced quantity in this upper part of the Wye catchment. NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—ANGLIAN REGION
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority Anglian Region by S. H.
